ABOUT CAMP STAFF

Louisiana Church of God Youth Camp is operated by the Louisiana Church of God Executive Offices located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana under the direct supervision of the State Youth & Discipleship Director and the State Youth & Discipleship Board. A complete background check is done for every staff application that we receive. We reserve the right to make decisions which are in the best interest of youth camp as it relates to staff and camper environment. Dorm Leaders and all camp staff/volunteers are to be a minimum of 18 years of age. All workers must have a signed endorsement from their local Church of God pastor. All workers are required to attend the mandatory staff orientation prior to the beginning of camp. We do not discriminate based on race, sex, or nationality.

CAMP INFORMATION

CAMP COST & REFUND POLICY: A \$50.00 non-refundable, non-transferrable, registration deposit must accompany this completed application for you to be officially pre-registered. All completed applications and deposits must be postmarked by June 1, 2025 in order to avoid the late fee. To guarantee a t-shirt order, size and money must be postmarked by June 1, 2025. The remaining balance is due upon arrival and start of Youth Camp. Cancellations will be honored if requested 14 days prior to the actual camp start date (**does not include \$50.00 non-refundable deposit**). All refunds will be processed after camps end in July.

CAMPER ARRIVAL & PICK-UP: ALL Campers should arrive at camp on Thursday, July 24th at 2PM. **NO CAMPER SHOULD ARRIVE EARLY!** All campers should be picked up promptly on Saturday at 3PM.

HEALTH SCREENING: In keeping with the policy of many schools and child-care facilities, every camper will be checked for head lice before they are permitted to check in or register. Professionals are secured to handle this process discreetly and proficiently. We adhere to a NO NIT policy. Anyone with head lice or nits WILL NOT be admitted to camp. We recommend that each camper be checked before leaving home, especially if traveling with a group. Abiding with current CDC guidelines and safety of our campers, a temperature check of each camper will be taken. Any camper with a temperature above 100.0 degrees will not be admitted to camp.

VISITOR POLICY

For the protection of all campers, all visitors must register at the Camp Office upon arrival. Visitors are not permitted to stay overnight but are welcome to attend the worship services. Visitors will be asked to leave the grounds at the dismissal of each worship service. (**Family visitors may cause homesickness for younger campers...use good judgment**).

DAMAGED AND LOST & FOUND POLICY

Louisiana Church of God is not responsible for stolen or lost personal items Lost items will be held for 30 days after Camp concludes. All items not picked up within 30 days will be disposed of. Regrettably, we cannot mail lost items. Campers should carefully pack their bags and double-check their areas to avoid left items.

VISITS & PHONE CALLS

Having your kids away from home can be tough. That is why we have pre-screened and trained all staff and personnel to handle any situation that may arise. Since camp is only a few days, please use wisdom when attempting to call your child, and be aware that visitors are allowed on campus during service times only. You can rest assured that we will contact you immediately if a problem occurs. In case of an emergency, call the Camp Director, Bishop Kevin Hendrix, at 256-295-3500.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Summers are hot in the south! Appropriate summer clothing is encouraged to beat the heat. But, don't forget to practice modesty and KEEP IT COVERED! Campers will be asked by the Head Dorm Leader to change their clothes in the case of a violation of the expected dress code, which includes short shorts & skirts, uncovered stomachs, spaghetti straps, clothing with inappropriate/vulgar language, and any other clothing deemed immodest by the Head Dorm Leaders.

WHAT TO WEAR

- * Short Sleeve T-Shirts
- * Tank Tops (*NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS*)
- * Modest Length Shorts (*Running shorts with compression shorts underneath are permitted; shorts should come to the tips of fingertips when arms are fully extended by their sides at minimum*)

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

- * Spaghetti Strap Tops
- * Low Cut Shirts
- * Halter/Strapless Tops
- * Crop Tops (*No stomachs showing*)
- * Short/Mini Skirts
- * Short Shorts
- * Biker Shorts/Spandex
- * Bikinis/Cheeky Swim Suits

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- * Anything of value that might be lost or damaged
 - * iPods, iPads, AirPods, Laptops, etc.
 - * Weapons
 - * Tobacco, Drugs, & Alcohol
 - * Fireworks / Sparklers / Poppers

CANTEEN

Snacks and drinks will be available at the Canteen. We recommend, if possible, \$5-\$10 per day for snacks and other items at the Canteen, including candy-grams. We want to provide a secure place for all cash brought to Louisiana Church of God Youth Camp. For this reason, you can purchase pre-paid Canteen Cash Cards for your child at Registration so your camper will not have to carry around cash. **Campers should use all the money on their Canteen Cash Cards. Unused Canteen Cash will not be refunded.**

FIRST AID / MEDICATIONS

All medications will be collected at the beginning of camp and will be administered only by the Camp Nurse. Prescriptions should be clearly labeled in appropriate bottles. **(Send only the exact amount needed for the time at camp).** Any and all special needs should be noted and included with medications.
